

Teacher's notes: Little Women Fact Sheet

Age:	Teenagers and adults
Level:	1
Reader:	This lesson can be used alongside the graded reader: https://readers.english.com/active/detail/9781292121444
Objectives:	Students create a fact sheet about themselves

Instructions:

It is recommended that students do this activity after reading the book.

Step 1: Display the fact sheet in the classroom for students to see or print copies for pairs of students. Give them a few minutes to read the fact sheet.

Step 2: Tell students they are going to compare themselves with the four sisters in the story. They read the fact sheet again and this time they identify the sentences that are true for them.

Step 3: Students create their own fact sheet using ideas from Step 2 and adding further information about themselves. To provide support, write the following categories on the board and tell students to think of facts about these areas of their lives: family and friends, physical appearance, personality, hobbies, hopes and dreams.

Step 4: Students share their fact sheets in small groups. If they wish to, they can give a short presentation to their group or to the class. Finally, display the fact sheets around the classroom and have students go around and read each other's work.
